Read: Mark 1:1-15

Jesus joined with many who came to John the Baptist at the Jordan River to be baptized. During His baptism, a voice came from heaven that said, “*You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased.*” This is from Psalm 2, a psalm used at coronation ceremonies of descendants of David when they were anointed as king; and from Isaiah 42, one of the Servant Songs. Hence Jesus arrives on the scene as the Servant King - One who came not to be served, but to serve and give Himself as a ransom for many.
