## Our Heart

**Read John 15:1-17.** To be a disciple of Jesus Christ means that we are connected to Him. It is NOT following rules or observing certain practices. It is a relationship, best understood as Jesus always giving Himself to us, as a vine provides nourishment to its branches. In this spring season you may have trimmed bushes or plants in your yard. If you look at the disconnected branches a day or so later, they are withering. That will happen to us spiritually if don't abide in Christ. Discover that He continually seeks to give His life to us. The joy of discipleship is recognizing that Jesus is moving toward us more than we are moving toward Him.
