A prisoner re-entry ministry meeting an individual's needs with dignity while embracing Christian values.

Kindway's programs and services are designed to assist its members and participants on their journey toward independence. Kindway has two program areas: Kindway SHARE operates The Shepherd's Place, a free clothing store that serves as a hub for social services; and Kindway EMBARK is an innovative, faith-based prisoner re-entry program.

The Shepherd's Place is a community outreach program of Kindway SHARE. We provide free clothing to any Ohio resident in need, regardless of income. The Shepherd's Place store and our donation center are staffed by volunteers.

EMBARK is an innovative offender reentry program that works with men and women returning to Central Ohio. Participants receive guidance and support as they navigate their journey from incarceration to independence. Its unique approach includes working with offenders prior to their release and providing support after their return to the community.

EMBARK accepts men and women that will be eligible for release or have a parole board hearing within 12-15 months of entry in the program. Candidates are carefully assessed for their readiness to participate in EMBARK. EMBARK trains volunteers from the community to deliver programs and services.
