QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

2. Read John 18:28-40. Jesus willingly submitted himself to circumstances like these. How do you think that felt to him? Why did he do it?
3. Read Psalm 22, which Jesus himself prayed on the cross. Notice how prayers of desperation go back and forth with prayers of confidence. How is this different from having just one or the other? Why does that matter?
4. Is there anything happening right now that you need to hand over to God in lament so that you can trust that he is sovereign over all of it?
